Catch up with my friends from back home. Although I've made incredible friendships at Caltech, I would never pass the opportunity to hang out with my day ones on a work-free day.



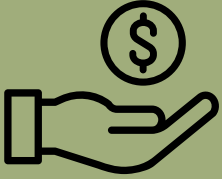

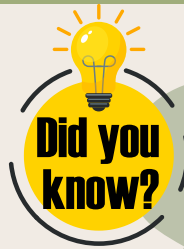
